2010 Enrichment Courses

(2-week class)

Seed-Bead Bracelets: This craft course is open to boys and girls, as the seed-beads come in a variety of colors. In week one, students will design their bracelets choosing colors and patterns. Week two will include an extra hour to enable the children to complete their bracelets to wear home! We look forward to seeing what our children will create! (This course is for children currently enrolled in Third and Fourth Grade.)

(4-week classes)

Spring into Spanish: This course is an introduction to the Spanish language. Students will explore the cultures of some Spanish speaking countries while learning greetings and simple phrases. They will be taught basic words such as colors, familiar references, and count from 1 to 10. Instruction will be through individual, small group, and whole group practice, using songs, charts, and interactive computer software. Course contents will vary slightly depending on age group. (This course is for ages 3-5 and children currently enrolled in Kindergarten/First Grade.)

Holidays Around the World: We will examine the traditions and customs of world holidays including Chinese New Year, Ramadan, May Day and Cinco de Mayo. Children will be exposed to the heritage and traditional dress of these cultures, while exploring customs through crafts, music, and interactive learning. (This course is for children currently enrolled in Kindergarten, First, and/or Second Grade.)

Introduction to Indonesian: Join Nike Guttridge for an introduction to the Indonesian language. Numerous Jack and Jill preschoolers have learned how to sing "We Wish you a Merry Christmas" while in Mrs. Guttridge's class and still remember it a year later! Through songs, visuals, and games, children will learn some language basics, as well as create simple projects each week to extend their learning. (This course is for children currently enrolled in Kindergarten/First Grade.)

Simple Stitches: This course will teach your child four basic stitches using a variety of colorful fabrics. Children will design and create a placemat showing running, herringbone, cross, and chain stitches. The creative stitching will enhance your child's fine-motor skills in a fun and exciting way. (This course is for children currently enrolled in First and Second Grade.)

Movement and Math: Register your preschooler to move and feel the beat as we explore math and movement all at the same time. This course will provide active learning experiences to enrich counting, patterns, sorting, rhymes, and movement. These hour-long sessions are certain to fly by with fun! (This course is for ages 3-5).

(8-week class)

Rockin' Recorders: This 8-week course will prepare students for public school instrumental programs by beginning to read music and playing the recorder. Musicianship will be developed through playing pitch matching games and performing rhythmic exercises. Each child will receive an instrument to keep, as well as a foundational music experience. (This course is for children currently enrolled in Second and Third Grade.)
